




Our November demo artist is **Jose Angel Hernandez** with a tribute painting of Frida Kahlo.

Jose was born in Puerto Rico and raised in the Northeast, graduated from high school in 1974 and later obtained a bachelor's degree in Business Administration in 1990. Jose is a self-taught artist that started painting in the year 2000. He built his art career and collector base while alternating his residence a couple of times between Los Angeles, CA, and Dallas, TX where he settled in after a 45-year career in the automotive industry. Jose is best known for his 3D Mixed Media Art.

As a contemporary artist, Jose seeks to arouse the curiosity and interest of art lovers looking for less traditional art. Jose's mission is to create interactive, playful art that evokes conversation. Each work of art is created with objects that he has either found, recycled, or purchased and then incorporated to add a three-dimensional component to the viewing experience. Getting to Know You - Kay Hoag






October Meeting and Exhibition Reception

12 to 22 pieces (depending on size)

Art must have D-Rings (wire not necessary)

If not framed, edges should be painted.

Title cards (Title – Medium – Price - Artist Name)

Artist's Bio (Single Page) (Prefer a thick stock paper)

Inventory sheet (Title – Size – Medium – and price for each)

No Nudes, nothing conspicuously religious, Nothing blatantly political.

Covid requirements may be in place according to the Heights Center.
